Why?

- To make Soteria a part of every mental health system around the globe
- There are many «Soteria –ideas» floating around
 - dissolution is a real danger... What are the core ideas of «Soteria»?
 - Are the core elements still «up-to-date»? What needs to be adapted?
- We need to join forces to make a difference
 - We need to have an impact on «mainstream psychiatry»
 - Implementing the WHO Guidance 2021
 - Reducing coercion in mainstream psychiatry
 - Contribute to a better mental health care system
 - «Soteria Fidelity Scale» has to be re-discussed and validated
 - We need to combine experience with research who takes part?

 - Internal organisation and reporting to the ISPD comittee is to be developed
 - Virtual or physical meetings of all participants at least once a year, or on demand.

- 2. Use the diverse Soteria community, to create a new Soteria identity
- 3. Contribute to a fundamental change in mental health services according to the WHO Guidances
- 4. Create aceptance and increase implementation for the Soteria Fidelity Scale SFS in «conventional psychiatry»
- 5. Further research and publications on Soteria
